RE: Transfer of DTE Gas Company subsidiary Saginaw Bay Pipeline Company, to DTE Michigan Gathering Holding Company

Dear Executive Secretary,

With this letter DTE Gas Company is providing written notice to the Michigan Public Service Commission (hereinafter referred to as the "Commission") of the pending transfer of its wholly owned subsidiary Saginaw Bay Pipeline Company to DTE Michigan Gathering Holding Company, pursuant to the affiliate transaction rules established in Case No. U-10149/U-10150. A complete description of the transaction is provided below.

THE PARTIES

DTE Gas Company is a subsidiary of DTE Energy Company, a Michigan corporation with its principal offices located at One Energy Plaza, Detroit, Michigan 48226. DTE Gas Company is a public utility subject to the jurisdiction of the Michigan Public Service Commission and is engaged in the acquisition, storage, transportation, distribution and sale of natural gas and other related services to approximately 1.2 million residential, commercial and industrial customers within the State of Michigan.

Saginaw Bay Pipeline Company is a Michigan corporation with offices at One Energy Plaza, Detroit, Michigan 48226. It currently owns and operates a 68-mile pipeline that transports natural gas and natural gas liquids from reserves in east-central Michigan to natural gas processing plants in Northern Michigan. Saginaw Bay Pipeline Company is a wholly owned subsidiary of DTE Gas Company.

DTE Michigan Gathering Holding Company is a Michigan corporation with offices at One Energy Plaza, Detroit, Michigan 48226. It is wholly owned by DTE Pipeline Company and is engaged in pipeline and gathering projects in Michigan.

DTE Pipeline Company is a Michigan corporation with offices at One Energy Plaza, Detroit, Michigan 48226. It owns interests in pipeline and processing projects directly and through its subsidiaries and partnerships. It is wholly owned by DTE Gas Enterprises, LLC.

THE TRANSACTIONS

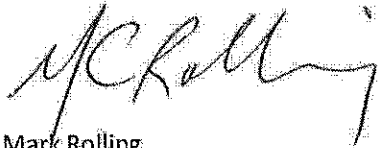
DTE Gas Company provides this notice to the Commission of the transfer of its wholly owned subsidiary Saginaw Bay Pipeline Company to DTE Michigan Gathering Holding Company. The transfer of assets is proposed at net book value as of August 31, 2013, which is believed to be equal to fair market value.

Accounting entries are shown on Attachment 1 in conformance with the MPSC Uniform System of Accounts. Gas Plant Instruction, Rule 5 G.

DATE OF TRANSFER

It is the Parties' understanding that Commission approval is not required prior to completing the transactions described above. In the event, however, that the Commission determines approval is required, please consider this letter a request for expedited approval so that the Parties may complete this transaction as soon as practicable. Absent written notice to the contrary within 30 days of the date of this letter, the Parties will assume no further action is required and will consummate the transaction as planned.
