ORDER

On May 27, 1999, the Commission issued an order (May 27 order) adopting an initial set of performance measures and benchmarks to be used in reviewing the compliance of Ameritech Michigan, now known as AT&T Michigan, with its obligation to provide nondiscriminatory access to its facilities and services, including unbundled network elements (UNEs), to competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs). The Commission has modified those measures and benchmarks in a number of orders issued after the May 27 order. A collaborative group of interested parties works together in regularly scheduled reviews to refine the performance measures and remedy plan. Participants in those collaborative efforts include AT&T Michigan, interested CLECs, and staff from state regulatory commissions from Michigan, Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, and Wisconsin. Changes agreed to are presented to the Commission for approval and adoption. The last Commission order issued in this proceeding was dated June 10, 2008.

On September 1, 2010, AT&T Michigan filed a report on the 2010 performance measures and remedy plan collaborative review. The previously approved changes to the performance measures and remedy plan included an end date of December 31, 2010. In its report, AT&T Michigan states that during a conference call, AT&T Michigan and the participating CLECs reached consensus that the current performance measures should continue without change and the current remedy plan be extended, without change, for two years, ending December 31, 2012. AT&T Michigan and the CLECs will incorporate the change into their respective interconnection agreements and submit those for Commission approval.

The Commission finds that it should accept the extension of the current performance measures and remedy plan until December 31, 2012. All other provisions remain in effect.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that the current performance measures and remedy plan, as approved by the Commission in its June 10, 2008 order should be amended to extend their effect until December 31, 2012.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the Michigan Court of Appeals, pursuant to MCL 484.2203(12).
