ORDER

On May 4, 1999, FiberNet of Michigan, L.L.C. (FiberNet), filed an application, pursuant to the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*, for a license to provide basic local exchange service. On August 17, 1999, the Commission granted the application. On May 26, 2009, FiberNet informed the Commission of its intent to surrender the license. FiberNet states that it has no customers and has ceased operations in Michigan.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

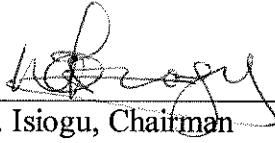
A. The license of FiberNet of Michigan, L.L.C., to provide basic local exchange service is rescinded.

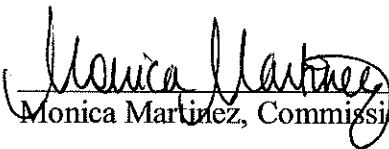
B. FiberNet of Michigan, L.L.C., shall surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so by the filing of a claim of appeal in the Michigan Court of Appeals within 30 days of the issuance of this order, under MCL 484.2203(12).
