Item II – Separation, Paragraph G.

An electric utility may transfer employees between the electric utility and any of its affiliates or other entities within the corporate structure as long as the electric utility documents those transfers and files semi-annually with the Commission a report of each occasion on which an employee of the electric utility became an employee of an affiliate or other entity within its corporate structure and/or an employee of an affiliate or other entity within its corporate structure became an employee of the utility.
