On February 3, 2000 the Commission issued an order finding that allowing the River Rouge Unit No. 1 powerplant to be an eligible facility as defined in the Public Utility Holding Company Act is in the public interest, would benefit customers and does not violate Michigan law.

The Commission premised its findings on six conditions set forth at pages 9 and 10 of the order unless the Company finds the conditions to be unacceptable and notifies the Commission within 10 days of the date of issuance of the order.

Detroit Edison accepts the conditions set forth in the Commission's order and will use its best efforts to sell the Rouge 1 capacity to marketers or retailers serving the Michigan retail access market at prevailing market prices. Detroit Edison commends the Commission's expeditious action to help insure that Rouge 1 capacity will be available to serve Michigan's electric demands this summer.
