The Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) will hold a public hearing to consider Consumers Energy Company's (Consumers) January 20, 2000 request for a certificate

of public convenience and necessity to render natural gas service in Sections 6 and 7 of Summerfield Township, Monroe County, Michigan. Consumers states that Michigan Gas Utilities currently provides natural gas service to the township.

A member of the public who wishes to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case, may participate by filing an appearance. To file the appearance, you must attend the hearing and advise the presiding administrative law judge of your wish to make a statement of position.
