To Whom it May Concern:

This report is submitted in response to the commission's June 19, 2000 order in the captioned docket for case number U-12486. Grayling Generating Station Limited Partnership (GGSLP) owns a 39 MW electrical power generating facility located in Grayling, MI. The primary fuel for the facility is wood biomass. Historically, the fuel mix was supplemented by tire derived fuel; however, the use of TDF was halted in January 2023 to meet the definition of a "renewable energy system" in accordance with Michigan Public Act 0235. The unit is not subject to the Mercury and Air Toxics Standard (MATS) under 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart UUUUU. No federal control reporting requirements for mercury are currently applicable to GGSLP's boiler unit; therefore, GGSLP is currently in compliance with applicable Federal mercury regulations.
