For Calendar Year 2025

To Whom It May Concern:

CMS Generation Michigan Power L.L.C. (CMSMP) is comprised of two individual electric generating facilities. The Livingston Generating Station is a 135 MW facility located in Gaylord, Michigan and the Kalamazoo River Generating Station is a 76 MW facility located in Comstock, Michigan. Both facilities are used to generate electricity for sale to the public utility grid system.

CMSMP's turbines and boilers are not subject to the final Mercury and Air Toxics Standards (MATS) rule, promulgated on February 16, 2012. These units do not meet the MATS applicability of "coal or oil-fired" electric utility steam generating units (EGUs) under §63.9982.

As stated in this letter, the requirements of the MATS standards do not apply to CMSMP. Therefore, please accept this letter as notice that CMSMP is not required to provide additional data in response to the Michigan Public Service Commission (MPSC) Case U-12486.
