To whom it may concern,

This report is submitted in response to the Commission's February 23, 2012 order in the captioned docket. The Commission ordered the owner or operator of each electrical power generating facility in Michigan to file a report detailing how it intends to comply with the Mercury and Air Toxics Standards (MATS). The Commission also ordered that the first report required under Case No. U-12486 be filed no later than May 23, 2012, and that each subsequent report be filed by January 31 of each succeeding year.

T.E.S. Filer City Station Limited Partnership ("TESFCSLP") owns a 72.5 MW nameplate capacity rating electric power generating facility located in Filer City, Michigan. The primary fuel for the TEFCSLP facility is coal. The facility also has the ability to utilize Tire Derived Fuel (TDF), petroleum coke, natural gas, and wood waste as fuels. However, TDF and pet-coke are no longer used at the facility for fuel. TEFCSLP has filed Initial Notification with the USEPA that it is subject to 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart UUUUU (MATS) and submits quarterly compliance reports for that regulation.

TESFCSLP has reviewed the MATS standard and determined that our existing pollution control devices are compliant with the proposed Maximum Achievable Control Technology (MACT) standards for our industry classification. TEFCSLP has reviewed the MATS monitoring standards and determined the current monitoring/testing program meets these standards. TEFCSLP has been fully compliant with all mercury related provisions within the MATS regulation.
