- The Michigan Public Service Commission will consider the request of the Association of Businesses Advocating Tariff Equity (ABATE) for a cease and desist order regarding The Detroit Edison Company's proposed transfer of assets to International Transmission Company.

On August 21, 2000, ABATE filed a request for a cease and desist order, or in the alternative, a declaratory ruling, regarding The Detroit Edison Company's proposed transfer of assets to International Transmission Company. On February 22, 2001, the Michigan Public Service Commission issued an order directing that a determination would be made, through a contested case proceeding, as to whether any of

the alternative forms of relief requested by ABATE should be granted or whether any additional actions are required to comply with the provisions of Public Act 141 of 2000.

The Commission has selected this case for participation in its Electronic Filings program. All documents filed in this case must be submitted in both paper and electronic versions.
