A. Keith Machen, being first duly sworn, states as follows:

1. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein and am competent to testify thereto as a witness.

2. I am A. Keith Machen of Ntegrity Telecontent Services, Inc. (Ntegrity). In this capacity, I negotiate interconnection agreements with incumbent local exchange carriers.

3. I am familiar with the steps taken that resulted in the Agreement executed as of May 31, 2000 by and between Ameritech Michigan and Ntegrity.

4. Exhibit A attached to the joint application is a genuine copy of the Agreement.

5. The Agreement meets all of the criteria for Commission approval under §§252(e)(1) and (2) of the Act.

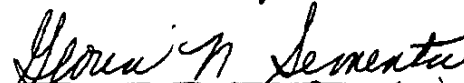
6. The Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. It is a comprehensive Agreement that tailors the interconnection and service arrangements previously approved by the Commission for local exchange competition to meet the individual needs of the parties and, thereby, will promote local exchange competition – one of the primary purposes of the Act and a long-standing goal of this Commission.

7. The Agreement will enhance Ntegrity's ability to provide residential and business customers in Ameritech Michigan's service territory with a competitive alternative for their local exchange service. Under the Agreement, more customers will be able to access Ntegrity's facilities. Customers will be able to choose Ntegrity instead of Ameritech Michigan for their local service, they will be able to change companies without changing their telephone numbers, and they will be able to call Ntegrity's customers and customers of other LECs without dialing special codes.
