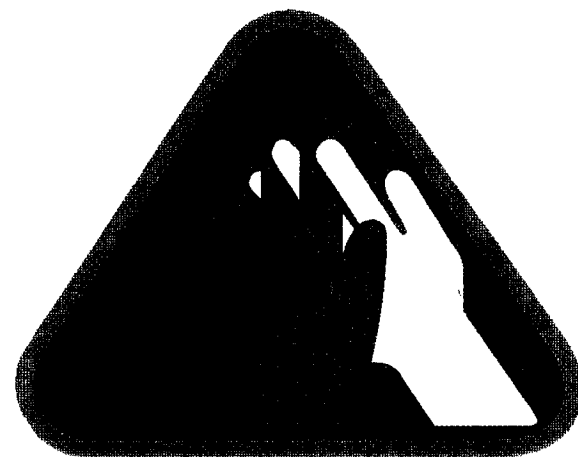

The Hubbard-Richard Community Council is a 501 C3 and was founded in November of 1964 at Preston Methodist Church to empower the community to create a better quality of life for the people of the area. Supported by various religious denominations and staffed by community organizers and VISTA volunteers, the HRCC spearheaded the creation of the Hubbard-Richard Citizen District Council to channel city resources into the neighborhood. In 1989/90 HRCC assisted in the creation of Mexican-Town Community Development

Corporation and the Bagley Housing Association. In response to the area's lack of recreational facilities, Hubbard-Richard CC was instrumental in the renovation and operation of the Roberto Clemente Recreation Center.

Purpose

The Hubbard-Richard Community Council organized to create a greater sense of cooperation among ourselves; to have a unified voice in all civic matters affecting our community; to maintain and improve our property to

develop a sense of personal responsibility to the neighborhood where we live.

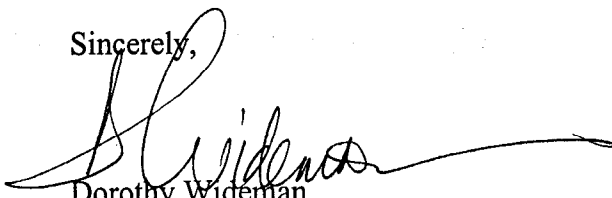
Dear Ms. Johnson:
