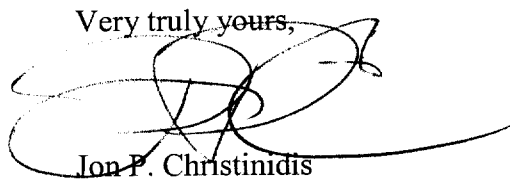

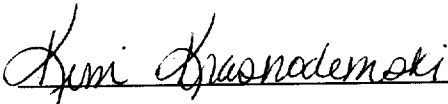

VERIFICATION

Ron May, being first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

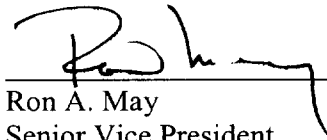
1. I am Senior Vice President, Energy Distribution for The Detroit Edison Company (“Detroit Edison”).
2. In that capacity, my duties included overseeing the completion of The International Transmission Company’s (“ITC”) system transmission projects identified in the “Joint Report” submitted by ITC on behalf of The Detroit Edison Company in MPSC Case No. U-12781. Those projects were identified as necessary and sufficient to comply with MCL 460.10v (2000 PA 141, Section 10v) that required, for electric utilities serving more than 100,000 retail customers in Michigan, an expansion of transmission capability by 2000 megawatts over that in place as of January 1, 2000. (MPSC Case No. U-12780/U-12781 Order dated July 23, 2002) A listing of the ITC transmission system projects was set forth in Hearing Exhibit A-5, page 23 of 25. A description of those projects and their disposition is attached to this Verification as Attachment 1.

3. On July 23, 2002, the Commission issued an order in Case Nos. U-12780/U-12781 that stated, in part, as follows:

First, the Joint Report technically complies with Section 10v because the record shows that it will achieve the required increase in transmission capacity. Second, once a utility has completed the projects identified in the Joint Report for its system and submitted appropriate verification, it will be deemed to be in technical compliance with Section 10v.

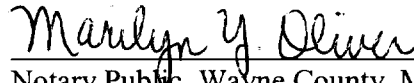
4. The projects listed on Attachment 1 to this Verification have been completed and are in commercial operation.

1. I am Vice President of Engineering for the International Transmission Company.

In that capacity, I am responsible for transmission planning, engineering, and system optimization.

2. On December 28, 2000 a joint plan was filed by ITC (on behalf of The Detroit Edison Company), Consumers Energy Company and Great Lakes Energy Cooperative with the Michigan Public Service Commission in Case No. U-12781. The projects identified in the plan were found by the Commission to be those necessary and sufficient to comply with MCL 460.10v (2000 PA 141, Section 10v) that required, for electric utilities serving more than 100,000 retail customers in Michigan, an expansion of transmission capability by 2,000 megawatts over that in place as of January 1, 2000. (MPSC Case No. U-12780/U-12781 Order dated July 23, 2002) A listing of the ITC transmission system projects was set forth in Hearing Exhibit A-5, page 23 of 25. A description of those projects and their disposition is attached to this Verification as Attachment 1.

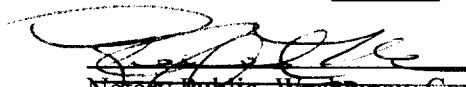
3. The projects listed on Attachment 1 to this Verification have been completed and are in commercial operation.
