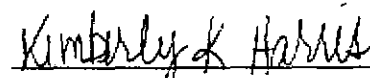

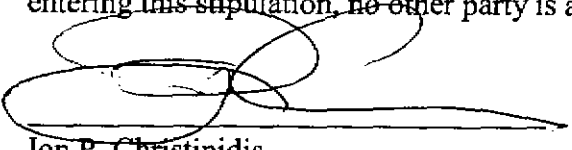

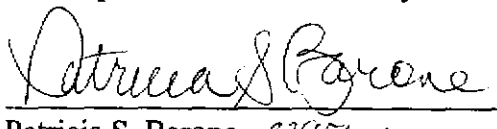

Stipulation to Admission of Attorney General as an Intervenor

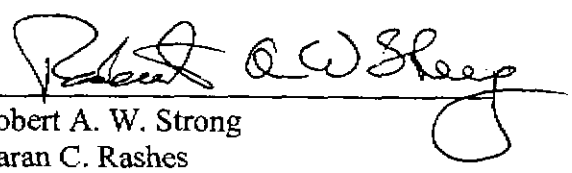
Attorney General Jennifer M. Granholm filed a "Notice of Intervention," but counsel on her behalf did not appear at the prehearing conference. The Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) granted intervenor status to ABATE, but did not act on the Attorney General's intervention at the prehearing conference. The ALJ also established a schedule for proceedings in this case. The Attorney General accepts the schedule established by the ALJ. Therefore, pursuant to MCL 24.278; MSA 3.560(178) and Rule 333(2) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure [R460.17333(2)], the parties stipulate to admission of the Attorney General as an intervenor. By entering this stipulation, no other party is agreeing with the positions of the Attorney General.

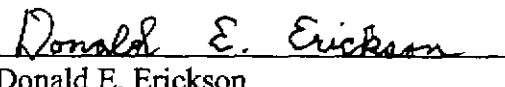
