Please accept these remarks as a reply to comments regarding Case. No. U-12915, specifically the provisions for net metering.

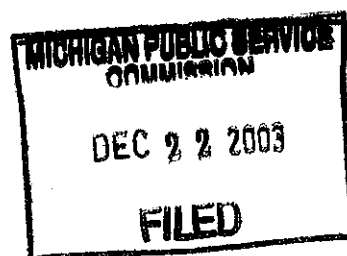

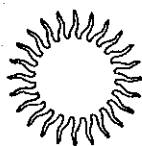
NET METERING RESOLUTION FOR MICHIGAN
