MOTION FOR CONSIDERATION OF CASH-ONLY PAYMENT ISSUE


BY THE MICHIGAN MUNICIPAL ASSOCIATION FOR UTILITY ISSUES

Pursuant to Michigan Administrative Rule 792.10437, the Michigan Municipal Association for Utility Issues (“MI-MAUI”) petitions the Michigan Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) for rehearing in this case based on a claim of error, specifically an error of omission. In its order of January 23, 2025 in this docket, the Commission noted that testimony had been received from MI-MAUI witness Bunch and DTE Electric Company (“DTE”) witness Sparks on the issue of cash-only payments. Order at p.16 (referencing Bunch testimony on “customer billing practices”) and p.19 (referencing Sparks rebuttal testimony to MI-MAUI “on the topic of cash payments”). However, the Commission’s January 23, 2025 Order does not contain any discussion of or render any decision on the cash-only payment issues (including but not limited to whether DTE’s tariff as proposed constitutes an illegal rate) that were the subject of the cited testimony as well as briefing by both MI-MAUI and DTE Electric Company.

MI-MAUI respectfully requests that the Commission a) issue a corrected order in which its determination regarding the cash-only payment issues is included; b) explicitly state the time period for rehearing or appeal of the Commission’s decision on that issue; c) ensure that time period selected by the Commission does not prejudice any party regarding timelines for

rehearing or appeal due to the error; and d) grant any and all other relief as is necessary and proper.
