ORDER

On March 4, 2009, Broadvox-CLEC, LLC (Broadvox) filed an application in this case, pursuant to the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*, for a license to provide basic local exchange service (BLES) throughout the state of Michigan in the zones and exchanges where Verizon North Inc.; Contel of the South, Inc., d/b/a Verizon North Systems; and AT&T Michigan are the incumbent local exchange carriers. On May 26, 2009, Broadvox was granted a permanent license.

On March 24, 2026, Broadvox filed a letter requesting to voluntarily surrender its license to provide BLES in Michigan (March 24 letter). The March 24 letter explains that Broadvox wishes to voluntarily surrender its license in the state of Michigan, and that the company does not have any customers.

The Commission finds that Broadvox's request to voluntarily surrender its license to provide BLES should be approved because the company does not have any customers and no longer wishes to retain its license to provide this service in Michigan.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. The request filed by Broadvox-CLEC, LLC, to voluntarily surrender its license to provide basic local exchange service is approved.

B. Broadvox-CLEC, LLC, shall surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it for the purpose of providing basic local exchange service in Michigan under the license.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 484.2203(12). To comply with the Michigan Rules of Court's requirement to notify the Commission of an appeal, appellants shall send required notices to both the Commission's Executive Secretary and to the Commission's Legal Counsel. 
