ORDER

On February 19, 2026, Randall Conway (Complainant) filed a formal complaint against DTE Electric Company (DTE Electric), alleging that DTE Electric failed to reasonably address and resolve repeated operational disruptions affecting his grid-tied solar photovoltaic system. That same day, Complainant's formal complaint was deemed not *prima facie*. On March 12, 2026, Complainant filed an amended formal complaint involving the same issue, which was then deemed to satisfy the *prima facie* requirements on March 13, 2026.

On June 26, 2026, the Administrative Law Judge Christopher S. Saunders filed a memo in this docket, stating that the Complainant had withdrawn his formal complaint because the Complainant expressed a desire to address his technical issue raised in his formal complaint by adding battery storage through DTE Electric's standard interconnection modification process.

The Commission finds that the formal complaint filed by the Complainant should be dismissed without prejudice because the Complainant has requested the dismissal in writing.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the amended formal complaint filed on March 12, 2026, by Randall Conway against DTE Electric Company is dismissed without prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26. To comply with the Michigan Rules of Court's requirement to notify the Commission of an appeal, appellants shall send required notices to both the Commission's Executive Secretary and to the Commission's Legal Counsel.

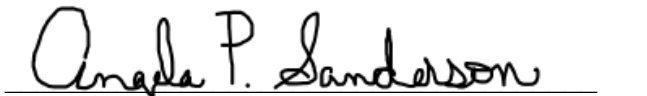
