ORDER

On May 1, 2026, Ezee Fiber Michigan Assets, LLC (Ezee Fiber Michigan) filed an application in this docket, with supporting testimony and exhibits, under the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*, for a temporary and permanent license to provide basic local exchange service throughout the state of Michigan. On June 8 and August 11, 2026, Ezee Fiber Michigan filed amended exhibits.

MCL 484.2301(2) states: “[p]ending the determination of an application for a license, the commission without notice and hearing may issue a temporary license for a period not to exceed 1 year.” The company states that it seeks a temporary license to allow it to enter the Michigan marketplace as soon as possible; to support Ezee Fiber Michigan’s ability to negotiate agreements with third parties, such as municipalities, which will be more easily navigated if Ezee Fiber Michigan can show it has received a temporary basic local exchange license; and to support Ezee

Fiber Michigan's ability to raise additional financing to fund its expansion in Michigan.

After a review of the application, testimony, and amended exhibits, the Commission finds that approval of the application for a temporary license is in the public interest and should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. Ezee Fiber Michigan Assets, LLC, is granted a temporary license to provide basic local exchange service throughout the state of Michigan. The temporary license shall expire upon issuance of the final order granting or denying the application for a permanent license, or a period not to exceed one year, whichever occurs first.

B. Ezee Fiber Michigan Assets, LLC, shall provide basic local exchange service under the temporary license in accordance with the regulatory requirements specified in the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*, including the number portability provisions of MCL 484.2358, the anti-slamming procedures adopted in Case No. U-11900, and the number reclamation process adopted in Case No. U-12703.

C. Before commencing basic local exchange service under the temporary license, Ezee Fiber Michigan Assets, LLC, shall submit its tariff reflecting the services that it will offer and identifying the exchanges in which it will offer service.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 484.2203(12). To comply with the Michigan Rules of Court's requirement to notify the Commission of an appeal, appellants shall send required notices to both the Commission's Executive Secretary and to the Commission's Legal Counsel. 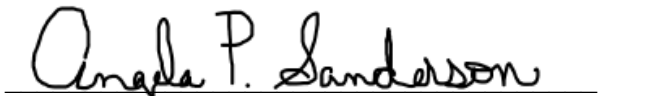
