JOINT APPLICATION

AT&T Michigan¹ and Broadwing Communications, LLC hereby jointly apply to the Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) pursuant to Section 203(1) of the Michigan Telecommunications Act (MTA), as amended, MCL 484.2203(1), and Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), for approval of the Thirteenth Amendment to the interconnection agreement between the parties heretofore approved by the Commission on March 29, 2001 (Agreement). In support of this joint application, AT&T Michigan and Broadwing Communications, LLC state as follows:

1. The parties have entered into good faith negotiations and have executed a Thirteenth Amendment to the Agreement. The Thirteenth Amendment to the Agreement, fully executed as of April 11, 2011, removes UNE and resale rates, terms and conditions from the Agreement. A copy of the Thirteenth Amendment to the Agreement, duly executed by the Parties, is submitted with this joint application as Exhibit A.

2. The Thirteenth Amendment is the result of voluntary negotiations and must be submitted to the Commission for its approval or rejection pursuant to Section 252(e)(1) of the Act. The Thirteenth Amendment meets all statutory criteria for Commission approval.

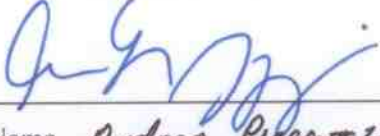

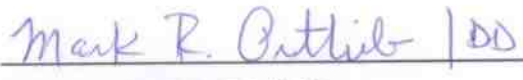

**AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
BROADWING COMMUNICATIONS, LLC
AND
MICHIGAN BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY d/b/a AT&T MICHIGAN**

This Amendment (the “Amendment”) amends the Interconnection Agreement by and between Michigan Bell Telephone Company¹ d/b/a AT&T Michigan (“AT&T Michigan”) and Broadwing Communications, LLC (“CLEC”). AT&T Michigan and CLEC are hereinafter referred to collectively as the “Parties” and individually as a “Party”.

WHEREAS, AT&T Michigan and CLEC are Parties to an Interconnection Agreement under Sections 251 and 252 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the “Act”), approved March 29, 2001 and as subsequently amended (the “Agreement”); and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual agreements set forth herein, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Modify the rates, terms and conditions of the Agreement as specified below:

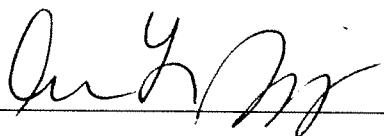
- delete the last four sentences in Section 4.7.3 of Article IV, “Transmission and Routing of Telephone Exchange Service Traffic Pursuant to Section 251(c)(2);
- delete “Coast’s Resale Services Customers via Resale Services or (ii)” from Section 7.1.1 of Article VII, “Telecommunications Carrier (TC) Services”;
- delete Article IX, “Unbundled Access – Section 251(c)(3)”, in its entirety;
- delete Article X, “Resale at Wholesale Rates – Section 251(c)(4)”, in its entirety;
- delete “and Resale Customers” from the heading in Section 15.1 and delete “Resale” after “Coast’s” in the first sentence of Section 15.1 of Article XV, “Directory Listings”;
- delete “additional services to Coast’s Resale Customers, and/or (iii)” in Section 15.2.5 of Article XV, “Directory Listings”
- delete the second sentence in Section 26.1 of Article XXVI, “Billing”, in its entirety;
- delete the third and fourth sentences in Section 29.7.1 of Article XXIX, “Miscellaneous”;
- delete “, resale or,” from Section 30.1 of Article XXX;
- delete the definitions of “Resale Implementation Questionnaire”, “Resale Services” and “Resale Tariff” in Schedule 1.2, “Definitions”;
- delete “the date Coast has completed and delivered to Ameritech the Resale Implementation Questionnaire and Ameritech has populated its billing systems with the information contained therein (iii)” from the definition of “Service Start Date” in Schedule 1.2, Definitions;
- delete Schedule 9.2.3A, “Promotional UNE Platform and Unbundled Local Switching with Interim Shared Transport”, in its entirety;
- delete Section 7.7, “Operator Services and Directory Assistance” of Article VII, “Telecommunications Carrier (TC) Services” in its entirety;
- delete Schedule 7.7.2, “OS/DA”, in its entirety
- delete Exhibit PS-X, “Operator Services and Directory Assistance (as a TC Service)”
- delete Schedule 10.1, “Resale Services”, in its entirety;

 - delete Pricing Schedule – Michigan in its entirety;
 - delete Appendix Pricing, Ameritech/CLEC, 9/20/00 in its entirety
 - delete Appendix DSL in its entirety
 - delete SBC Michigan Amendment Pricing U-11831 in its entirety;
 - delete Amendment-MPSC September 21, 2004 Order, Case No 13531 in its entirety;
 - delete Amendment – MPSC January 25, 2005 Final Order – Case No. U-13531 in its entirety;
 - delete Amendment-Conforming to TRO/TRRO, fully executed as of 2/17/06, in its entirety
 - delete Amendment REGCPORDMI 11982 Revising Conforming Post TRO Remand, fully executed as of 5/22/08, in its entirety
 - Exhibit A to this Amendment is incorporated into the Agreement and replaces the existing rates in this Agreement, except that applicable tariff references shall remain in effect.
2. It is the intent of this Amendment to remove all Resale, OS/DA and UNE rates, terms and conditions from the Agreement. In the event any such rates, terms and conditions remain in this Agreement, they shall be deemed deleted by this Amendment.
3. Conflict between this Amendment and the Agreement. This Amendment shall be deemed to revise the terms and provisions of the Agreement only to the extent necessary to give effect to the terms and provisions of the Amendment. In the event of a conflict between the terms and provisions of this Amendment and the terms and provisions of the Agreement, this Amendment shall govern; provided, however, that the fact that a term or provision appears in this Amendment but not in the Agreement, or in the Agreement but not in this Amendment, shall not be interpreted as or deemed grounds for finding a conflict for purposes of this Section 3.
4. This Amendment may require that certain sections of the Agreement be replaced and/or modified by the provisions set forth in this Amendment. The Parties agree that such replacement and/or modification be accomplished without the necessity of physically removing, replacing or modifying such language throughout the Agreement.
5. In entering into this Amendment, neither Party waives, and each Party expressly reserves, any rights, remedies or arguments it may have at law or under the intervening law or regulatory change provisions in the underlying Agreement (including intervening law rights asserted by either Party via written notice predating this Amendment) with respect to any orders, decisions, legislation or proceedings and any remands thereof, which the Parties have not yet fully incorporated into this Agreement or which may be the subject of further review.
6. EXCEPT AS MODIFIED HEREIN, ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE UNDERLYING AGREEMENT SHALL REMAIN UNCHANGED AND IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
7. This Amendment shall not modify or extend the Effective Date or Term of the underlying Agreement, but rather, shall be coterminous with such Agreement.
8. This Amendment shall be filed with and is subject to approval by the State Commission and shall become effective ten (10) days following approval by such Commission.
