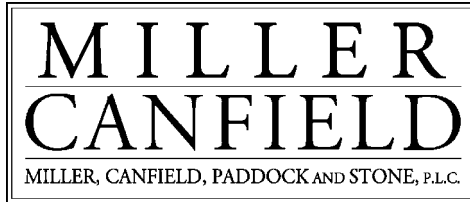

**CLARIFICATION OF
KALEVA TELEPHONE COMPANY'S PETITION FOR REHEARING**

Kaleva Telephone Company (Kaleva), through its attorneys, Miller, Canfield, Paddock and Stone, PLC, files this clarification to its January 22, 2007 Petition for Rehearing (Petition) in the above matter. Subsequent to Kaleva's filing of the Petition, the Commission Staff (Staff) and Kaleva's counsel had discussions regarding a potential ambiguity contained therein. Kaleva therefore files this pleading to clear up the potential ambiguity.

The Petition contains the following discussion:

. . . . Rather than providing 2,000 minutes in local calling to the non-adjacent exchanges, Kaleva would provide 12,000 voice minutes in local calling to the non-adjacent exchanges.

As set forth in ¶¶ 7 and 8 to the Revised Application, Kaleva would provide PBLES customers with 100 outgoing voice calls per line per month, and 12,000 outgoing voice minutes per line per month, in local calling to (1) their home exchange, (2) any exchange that is adjacent to their home exchange, and (3) any exchange that is adjacent to any other Kaleva exchange. As a result, all Kaleva PBLES customers would have 100 outgoing voice calls and 12,000 outgoing voice minutes per month to all exchanges listed in columns (2), (3), and (4) above. Charges for exceeding the monthly 100 outgoing voice calls and 12,000 outgoing voice minutes allowances would continue to apply, but such charges are not proposed to be changed

with the Revised Application. [Petition for Rehearing, p 5 (footnote omitted).]

Kaleva advises that the first sentence quoted above (beginning "Rather . . ." and ending ". . . non-adjacent exchanges.") should be deleted from the Petition. Instead, the sentence should be substituted with the following: "Kaleva would provide 12,000 minutes in local voice calling to the home exchange, all adjacent exchanges, and all exchanges adjacent to any Kaleva Telephone Company exchange, as explained in more detail in the following paragraph."

In making the above substitution of sentences, Kaleva makes clear that its PBLES would provide 100 monthly outgoing voice calls and 12,000 monthly outgoing voice minutes to the exchanges in the proposed local calling area (see columns (2), (3), and (4) of ¶ to the Revised Application). In so doing, Kaleva removes the potential, unintended, interpretation that the monthly calls and minutes allowances for calls to non-adjacent exchanges would apply separately from calls to the PBLES customer's home and adjacent exchanges.
