ORDER

The following parties have filed joint applications for approval of interconnection agreements
or amendments to an interconnection agreement:

Case No. U-11962	AT&T Michigan and Global Crossing Local Services, Inc. Application filed September 26, 2018, for approval of an eighth amendment to the interconnection agreement (extends the term of the seventh amendment pertaining to the approved Performance Measures and Remedies Plan to December 31, 2020).
Case No. U-12798	AT&T Michigan and Broadwing Communications, LLC Application filed September 26, 2018, for approval of a seventeenth amendment to the interconnection agreement (extends the term of the sixteenth amendment pertaining to the approved Performance Measures and Remedies Plan to December 31, 2020).
Case No. U-15027	AT&T Michigan and TelCove Operations, LLC Application filed September 26, 2018, for approval of a fourth amendment to the interconnection agreement (extends the term of the third amendment pertaining to the approved Performance Measures and Remedies Plan to December 31, 2020).

- Case No. U-17143 AT&T Michigan and New Horizons Communications Corp.
Application filed October 3, 2018, for approval of a first amendment to the interconnection agreement (adds terms and conditions to implement the Connect America Fund et al., WC Docket No. 10-90 et al., Report and Order, FCC 11-161, issued November 18, 2011, and FCC 11-189, amended on December 23, 2011; and includes a name change in the state of North Carolina).
- Case No. U-18387 AT&T Michigan and Onvoy Spectrum, LLC
Application filed September 10, 2018, and an amended application filed October 9, 2018, for approval of a first amendment to the interconnection agreement (adds the states of California and Kansas; and adds provisions regarding the wireless interconnection agreement between Nevada Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Nevada, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Kansas, and Onvoy Spectrum, LLC).
- Case No. U-18398 AT&T Michigan and Airus, Inc.
Application filed October 5, 2018, for approval of a first amendment to the interconnection agreement (adds the state of South Carolina).
- Case No. U-20308 AT&T Michigan and Uniti Fiber, LLC
Application filed September 14, 2018, for approval of an interconnection agreement.

47 USC 252(e)(2) and (3) provides in part:

- (2) The State commission may only reject
 - (A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation under subsection (a) of this section if it finds that--
 - (i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or
 - (ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity; . . .
- (3) Notwithstanding paragraph (2), but subject to section 253 of this title, nothing in this section shall prohibit a State commission from establishing or enforcing other requirements of State law in its review of an agreement, including requiring compliance with intrastate telecommunications service quality standards or requirements.

After reviewing the applications, the Commission finds that they should be approved. The Commission finds that the agreements and amendments are consistent with federal and state law

and are in the public interest. Under 47 USC 252(i) and MCL 484.2359(2), the services provided under the agreements shall be made available to other telecommunications carriers upon the same terms and conditions.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. The interconnection agreements and amendments listed above are approved.

B. Approval of the interconnection agreements and amendments does not alter the duty of the parties to comply with relevant federal and state law and past and future Commission orders and rules.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party aggrieved by this order may file an action in the appropriate federal District Court under 47 USC 252(e)(6). To comply with the requirement to notify the Commission of an appeal, appellants shall send required notices to both the Commission's Executive Secretary and to the Commission's Legal Counsel. 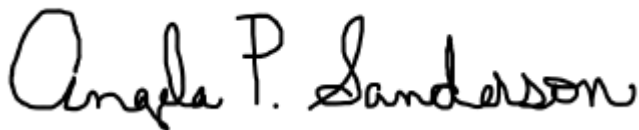
