Surrender of License to Provide Basic Local Exchange Service**

Dear Ms. Kunkle,

I am writing to request surrender of Peninsula Telephone Company's (PenTel) license to provide basic local exchange service. PenTel received its license to provide basic local exchange service in the Old Mission exchange by virtue of the Commission's August 14, 1992 Order in Case No. U-10054.

PenTel is surrendering its basic local exchange service license because it no longer provides such service in Michigan. PenTel sold its telecommunications assets to Ace Telephone Company of Michigan on December 31, 2010. PenTel therefore has no basic local exchange service customers.

Ace Telephone Company of Michigan now provides basic local exchange service in the Old Mission exchange in accordance with the license granted by the Commission's December 21, 2010 Order in Case No. U-16468. As reflected in a Public Notice dated January 3, 2011, the Federal Communications Commission approved the sale of PenTel's assets to Ace Telephone Company of Michigan effective December 31, 2010 (WC Docket No. 10-232).

I am filing an original and fifteen (15) copies of this letter in accordance with the Commission's procedural rules.
